

Overseas Academic Presentation Scholarship for Graduate Students

A: Applicant's Qualification

- 1) Must be a current student in a master's or PhD program of Chulalongkorn University.
- 2) Thesis or dissertation proposal must have been authorized by the administrative board of the faculty/interdisciplinary.
- 3) Must not be a studentship that is fully supported for overseas academic presentation.
- 4) Never receive a partial or full support for overseas academic presentation from the faculty or other grants.
- 5) Must have oral or poster presentation in the conference or symposium.
- 6) A manuscript or full paper involving an applicant's presentation must be submitted/accepted or published in ISI or SCOPUS databases: journal for PhD students and journal/proceedings for Master's student.
 - i) Proceedings published in a form of a special issue in an endorsed journal are classified as "Journal".
 - ii) Publication types in ISI/SCOPUS databases are classified as stated in ISI, SCOPUS or SJR.
 - iii) Prepared manuscript may be accepted for application, but must be submitted within 20 days after the end of the conference/symposium.

B: Application Process

An applicant must submit a complete application form, including the following documents for scholarship consideration, to Graduate School via his/her program and faculty at least 30-days before departure date to the conference/symposium.

- 1) An acceptance letter/email showing to be a part of the Oral/Poster Presentation may be included or submitted before payment claim. The payment will be canceled if these documents are not shown.
- 2) Details involving the conference/symposium (daily program, registration rate etc.)
- 3) (i) Abstract presented at the overseas academic presentation and
(ii) Manuscript or full paper submitted or accepted or published in the proceedings or journal.
- 4) Evidence showing that above proceedings or journal is categorized in ISI or SCOPUS databases.
- 5) Expenses approximation within the amount of financial support.
- 6) The document showing the authorized proposal of thesis/dissertation.

C: Consideration Criteria

- 1) International conference/symposium must relate to the applicant's field of study, and be held in overseas.
- 2) A presentation research must be update and mainly conducted in Thailand, also processes highly academic quality and benefit.
- 3) An applicant must be the first author of this presentation.
- 4) The Graduate School has no policy to support any applicant whose manuscript or full paper is not submitted/accepted or published in the proceedings or journal in ISI or SCOPUS databases.
- 5) The applicant's faculty or program may assign reviewers to evaluate the applicant's presentation paper.

D: Financial Support for Oral or Poster Presentation

For PhD Program Student: in the amount of not over than 60,000 THB

Registration fees as charged; not over than	18,000 THB
Airplane Transportation Fees as charged in Economy Class only; not over than	30,000 THB
Daily allowance and accommodation; not over than (4,000 THB/day for 3 days)	12,000 THB

For Master's Program Student: in amount of not over 40,000 THB

Registration fees as charged; not over than	15,000 THB
Airplane Transportation Fees as charged in Economy Class only; not over than	16,000 THB
Daily allowance and accommodation; not over than (3,000 THB/day for 3 days)	9,000 THB

Remark: Graduate School will support 50% of the total amount, and another 50% will be paid by the applicant's faculty and/or program, except that Graduate School will support 100% for PhD student under the following scholarship: i) The 100th Anniversary Chulalongkorn University Fund for Doctoral Scholarship or i) H.M. King Bhumibol Adulyadej's 72nd Birthday Anniversary Scholarship.

E: Scholarship Termination

- 1) Recipient is no longer a student at Chulalongkorn University before the departure date to the conference/symposium (graduated, left off the study, and resigned). Except for the recipient who graduated in the first semester of the academic year, the presentation date must be within the second semester of the same academic year.
- 2) An acceptance letter/email to be part of the Oral/Poster Presentation is not submitted before payment claim.

F: Payment Claim

The recipient must submit the following documents within 20 days after the end of the conference/symposium presentation.

- 1) Registration Receipt with the document showing exchange rate issued by the Bank of Thailand
- 2) Airplane Ticket Receipt of Economy Class or E-ticket and Boarding pass
- 3) Accommodation Receipt issued by the hotel
- 4) Payment Certificate for Daily Allowance
- 5) Transportation Report for Academic Presentation
- 6) Academic Presentation Report at International Conference or Symposium

G: Conditions for Scholarship Recipient

- 1) Recipient must contribute knowledge gained from International Conference/Symposium within one month by giving a lecture/seminar or other activities that are benefit for graduate studies. Recipient must report this contribution to Graduate School within one month.
- 2) If recipient's full paper is published in the journal, recipient should report to Graduate School as well.
