As it is deemed propriate to ensure the Admission to Graduate Programs, Academic Year 2025 to proceed smoothly. By virtue of Article 8 of Chulalongkorn University Regulations on Graduate Studies, 2018 (B.E. 2561) and Article 7, Clause 2 of Chulalongkorn University Regulations on Graduate Studies, 2023 (B.E. 2566) hereby stipulated the following announcement regarding the Admission to Graduate Programs, Academic Year 2025.

Semester System

- *2nd Semester Academic Year 2025, applying process starts on 1 June 2025 onwards. See the timeline of each program.

Trimester System

- *1st semester academic Year 2025 applying process starts on 1 February 2025 onwards. See the timeline of each program.
- 2nd Semester Academic Year 2025, applying process starts on 1 June 2025 onwards. See the timeline of each program.
- ❖3rd Semester Academic Year 2025 (if any) applying process starts during 1-15 February 2025. See the timeline of each program.

2. Applicant's Qualification

2.1 Ph.D. Program

- (1) An applicant must have previously completed the master's degree or **, or** equivalent. Or
- (2) An applicant must have completed a Bachelor's degree or equivalent in the same field as the doctoral program the applicant intended to study or in other fields as determined by the Program Board and holds a bachelor's degree with honors. Or obtaining cumulative grade point average not lower than 3.25 or equivalent.

2.2 Advanced Diploma Program

An applicant must have completed a master's degree or equivalent.

- 2.3 Master's degree Program An applicant must have completed a Bachelor's degree program or equivalent. Or studying in the Bachelor's degree program in which continuing program at taught bachelor's or master's degree is teaching by the university. In this regard, the regulations and conditions prescribed by the Program Board.
- **2.4 Graduate Diploma Program** An applicant must have completed a Bachelor's degree or equivalent.

An applicant to each degree must have graduated or currently studying in the program accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation in the final semester, and must meet the additionally required qualifications as mentioned in each program's attached file, and must be approved to apply by Program Board.

2.2 Advanced Diploma Program

An applicant must have completed a six-year Bachelor's degree program or must have completed a master's degree or equivalent, except in a special Professional Program, the program may accept the Diploma Program graduates.

- 2.3 Master's degree Program An applicant must have completed a six-year Bachelor's degree program or equivalent. For those who want to take Plan A Form A1 must have completed a Bachelor's degree in the same field as the program they intend to apply.
- **2.4 Graduate Diploma Program** An applicant must have completed a Bachelor's degree or equivalent.

An applicant to each degree must have graduated or currently studying in the program accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation in the final semester, and must meet the additionally required qualifications as mentioned in each program's attached file, and must be approved to apply by Program Board.

In case of applicant still have not obtained the official academic document as prescribed by the university, the admission will be fully effective when the applicant has successfully submitted the official graduation document or official academic transcript for continuing program to the Office of Registrar within

4. English language proficiency test scores

According to the announcement of Chulalongkorn University on the English language proficiency test scores, for those who want to apply for Ph.D. Program and master's degree Program, B.E. 2557 (2014) and 2nd edition B.E. 2558 (2015), their score result must be valid not more than two years on the day the scores announced to the day of admission to each program as mentioned in each program's attached file.

If in case deemed necessary, applicant is failed to submit the English language proficiency scores in time as stipulated by the Graduate School, Program's coordinator is in charge to contact CUGS directly.

5. Process of application

5.1 Regular program

- 5.1.1 An applicant must fill in the application data ONLINE at www.grad.chula.ac.th (Menu: Admission > Admission System) correctly and completely.
- 5.1.2 An applicant can apply to study in more than one program when the applicant's examination dates are different. However, the applicant can study in one program only.
- 5.1.3 One application form is applicable to one program only and when the application is confirmed, the applicant will not be able to change the program in the same application form. If the applicant fills up the wrong program, the applicant must fill in a new application form and pay the application fees accordingly. CUGS reserves its rights not to refund the application fees.
- 5.2 Irregular, International, English and Extra Fee Programs: An applicant must check the application process as mentioned in each program's attached file. Application documents and fees must be sent to each program as announced.
- **6. Accompanying application documents** (Upload.pdf file no. 6.1, 6.3, and 6.5 in application system)
 - 6.1 **Scan** national ID card or a copy of government official ID card.
- 6.2 A copy of marriage certificate/name-surname changing certificate (In case of unmatched document).

6.3 **Scan** the academic transcript. For those who have already graduated, specify grades of all courses or cumulative grade point average (GPA). For those who are studying in the final year of program must show a verified document of scores of all taken courses.

6.4 A copy of verified document of scores of taken courses in a Diploma program or equivalent must be complied with conditions of each program as mentioned in each program's attached file.

6.5 Scan the report of English/Thai tests score of Chulalongkorn University Academic Test Center (CU-TEP/CU-TEP E-Testing) or TOEFL examination score report (only TOEFL iBT or TOEFL ITP) or IELTS score report (the score report must be valid not more than two years on the day the scores announced to the day of admission as mentioned in each program's attached file.)

Applicant is strongly advised that English language proficiency test scores other than mentioned above will not be accepted.

6.6 A certified document of employment/a letter of recommendation as mentioned in each program's attached file.

6.7 For other accompanying documents as mentioned in each program's attached file, **the applicant must send them directly** to the department address announced in the application system or specified by each program.

If CUGS later discovered that the information given in the application form or any application documents is inaccurate or counterfeit, CUGS reserves the right to take the legal action to the full extent of law and applicant will have the student's status revoked, if he /she has been accepted as the student.

6.8 Payment of application fees

1) **500-baht application fees for Regular Program** must be paid at CUGS (Chulalongkorn University Graduate School). In this regard, the application fees must be paid within the last date of application of each program.

2) For Irregular, International, English, Extra Fee Programs, see each program's attached file.

Be noted that "Application Fees" are not the same as "Examination Fees". If the applicant refrains from sitting in the examination room for whatever reason, the applicant cannot refund the application fees. If the program cannot be run for any reason, CUGS will refund the application fees to the applicant.

7. Announcement of the eligible candidates for entrance examination/accepted candidates

7.1 An applicant must check the date of announcement of eligible candidates /accepted candidates in each program's attached file at http://www.grad.chula.ac.th (Menu: Admission > Admission System > Curriculum).

7.2 An applicant must check the list of eligible candidates/accepted candidates in each program's attached file at http://www.register.gradchula.com by logging on the system and proceed to Admission System.
